

# Activity Bus Trip Rules

Emmett School District #221

The following guidelines are to be used by ALL Teachers, Coaches, Advisors, etc... on all trips. The student conduct on trips is the same that is expected on regular school bus routes. Trips may cause the driver to be placed in a very high stress condition. This type of bus trip is intended to be a fun trip, and is subject to the same rules that apply on a regular bus route, but safety is the first consideration.

1. We ask that the Teachers, Coaches, Advisors, etc... space themselves the length of the bus to better control the students.
2. Students are to **remain seated at all times** until the bus is stopped.
3. If a Teacher, Coach, Advisor, etc... needs to talk with a student, they need to notify the driver that they are going to get up and then move to that student. Please do not ask the student to come up to you.
4. Keep the isle clear of legs and carry-on articles. Store articles under bus or in rear seats.
5. All cleats must be removed before entering the bus.
6. Keep noise level at a conversational level. When approaching and while crossing Railroad Tracks remain silent. Singing and clapping are very annoying to a driver that is trying concentrate on road conditions, other traffic, lane changes and following road signs.
7. Use of profane language, alcohol, tobacco, drugs or any other controlled substance is not permitted.
8. Eating and drinking are allowed on trips. Please make sure and use the trashcans provided. (Especially with sunflower seeds! These are very hard to get cleaned up.)
9. Extending any body part, or any other object out of the windows is prohibited.
10. Save the horseplay and wrestling for outside the bus,
11. Remember that you are representing the Emmett School District when you travel out of town. Show courtesy and respect to other people.
12. Cell Phones: Ringers should be turned off, No Flash pictures, it reflects in the mirror and could cause the driver to be blinded and or distracted. Headphones must be worn if you want to listen to personal device music.
