

Teacher Grants - Fall

This Fall's cycle of Teacher Grants from the Emmett Public School Foundation has awarded \$7,464.21 to area teachers to be able to enhance the educational experience for their students. Projects funded included a 4th grade field trip for students at Carberry Elementary to the newly remodeled Idaho Historical Museum in Boise for their Idaho History studies, a high school biotechnology project to conduct actual research and study the Giant Panda population, money to replenish resources in Emmett High School's library, cup stacking equipment for the physical education departments at Carberry Elementary and Shadow Butte Elementary, sensory stimulation materials for the Emmett School District Preschool, chairs for project-based learning for the high school World History students, and materials/professional to conduct art lessons in leather tying at Shadow Butte Elementary. These monies are made available to the Emmett Public School Foundation from the Dean and Gay Welch donation that provides an annual amount from a fund set up through the Idaho Community Foundation.
